Major Project



Healthcare & Humanitarian Services

STATE : Bada Gaon Hamirpur, Uttar Pradesh

In the small village of Bada Gaon, tucked away in rural Uttar Pradesh, access to healthcare had always been a distant dream. Most families survived on daily wages, with little means to travel to distant towns for medical treatment. Preventable illnesses often went untreated, and children suffered silently due to lack of proper nutrition and diagnosis.

Recognizing this urgent need, Atma Vani Welfare Society organized a Health Diagnostics Camp in the heart of the village. The initiative brought together doctors, nurses, and volunteers, all determined to extend life-saving support to the underserved community.

From early morning, villagers began gathering at the camp site—mothers holding children, elderly men walking with support, and young people eager to understand their health better. For many, this was their first ever medical check-up.

The camp provided:

- Free diagnostic tests for blood pressure, diabetes, anemia, and common infections.
- Nutritional assessments for children, ensuring early detection of malnutrition.
- Distribution of essential medicines and hygiene kits.
- Awareness sessions on clean water, sanitation, and preventive healthcare.

One of the beneficiaries was Meera, a 10-year-old girl who had been constantly weak and tired. Through the camp's screening, she was diagnosed with anemia. With timely treatment and nutritional guidance, Meera now attends school regularly with renewed energy and enthusiasm.

By the end of the day, the camp had served over 300 villagers, offering not just medical support but also hope and reassurance. The smiles on the faces of the community members reflected the true spirit of Atma Vani's mission—to bring care and dignity to those who need it most.





Education & Child Development

STATE : Bagdari, Madhya Pradesh

In the remote village of Bagdari, many children dreamed of a better future but lacked the tools to compete in today's digital world. With no access to computers at school and limited resources at home, technology felt like a distant reality for most of them.

To bridge this gap, Atma Vani Welfare Society launched a Computer Skill Development Program for underprivileged children. The training center was set up with refurbished computers, internet access, and dedicated trainers who guided students through the basics of digital literacy—typing, using educational software, and safe internet browsing.

Children who once struggled with handwriting now learned to prepare documents, create presentations, and explore interactive learning tools. For the first time, they could see themselves not just as students of a small village school, but as future professionals ready to take on the world.



Environment & Sustainable Living

STATE : Sitapur, Uttar Pradesh

In Sitapur district of Uttar Pradesh, small farmers often struggled with low crop yields, high input costs, and debt from chemical fertilizers. Many felt trapped in a cycle that barely sustained their families.

To address this, Atma Vani Welfare Society introduced an Organic Farming and Livelihood Project, training farmers in sustainable practices such as composting, crop rotation, and natural pest management. Alongside training, farmers were also supported with seeds, tools, and access to local markets to sell their produce at fair prices.

The project has so far engaged over 200 farmers, helping them transition to sustainable farming while improving their income and health. Beyond the financial benefits, the initiative has restored pride and confidence among rural families, proving that organic farming is not just a livelihood, but a way forward for a healthier future.



Women's Empowerment & Community Engagement

STATE : Etawah, Uttar Pradesh

In the rural village of Etawah , young girls often grew up with limited opportunities beyond household work and basic schooling. Computers and digital technology were out of reach, leaving them unprepared for the modern world.

To break this barrier, Atma Vani Welfare Society implemented the PMGDISHA (Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan) program, focusing on empowering adolescent girls through digital literacy. With laptops, tablets, and trained instructors, the program introduced them to typing, internet use, online learning platforms, and digital safety.

One of the participants, Rani, a 16-year-old daughter of a farmer, had never touched a computer before. Within three months of training, she was creating documents, searching educational resources online, and even teaching her younger siblings. Today, Rani dreams of pursuing higher education in computer applications—a possibility she never imagined before PMGDISHA.
